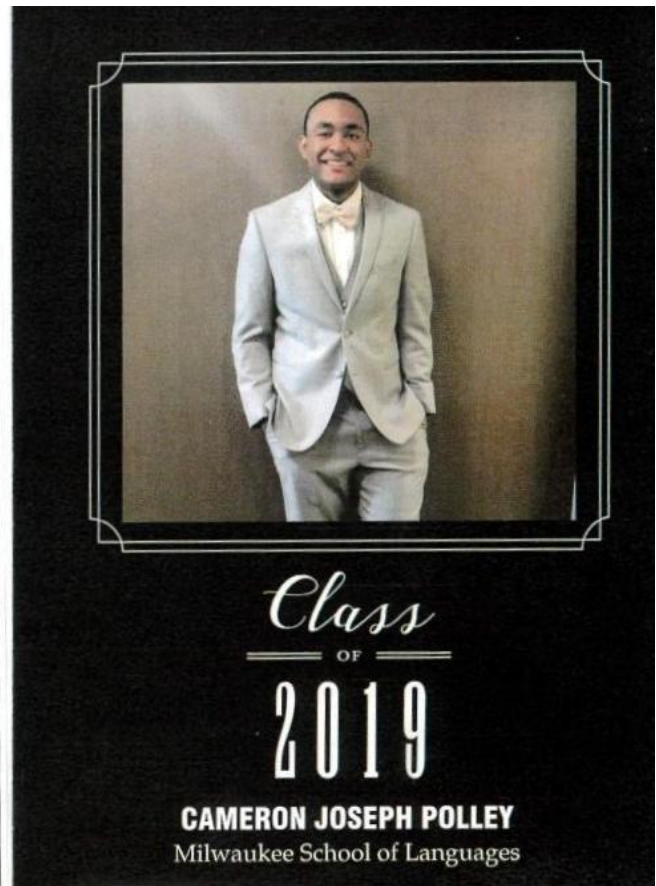

## Congregational Development Coaching Featuring Bishop Ed Leidel

Maybe some St Francis Parish members have heard or possibly have not heard that your 2019 Vestry has entered into an agreement with Bishop Ed Leidel to participate in a four month partnership with him coaching our group. Bishop Ed has worked in many Parishes throughout our Country and feels that through his coaching efforts, St Francis Vestry and Leadership will better be prepared for the future and for finding a Pastor. Your Vestry believes Bishop Ed's Coaching will enhance their efforts to create a vision and sense of purpose throughout, develop a strategic plan, help develop a plan to find a new Priest or Pastor and to create a plan and action steps for continuous improvement.

This past Saturday, May 25 we began this trek with Bishop Ed. This days focus was on "Team Building". To begin with each Vestry member and attendee was asked to complete the Meyers Briggs test for individuals. This MBTI Team Building exercise gave us a chance to see where our personality traits fell into place with each other. Believe me when I say we were mostly just a little bit different with each other. It did show us our dominant functions as two were compassionate harmonizers, two were logical processors, three were intuitive visionaries and four were practical stabilizers. After we discussed what each one meant we talked about temperaments and what that meant. Six people were order people, three people were people, people and two were idea people.

All in All it was a very good introduction into Team Building and we All walked out of the First Session knowing some new and very interesting things we didn't know about each other.
