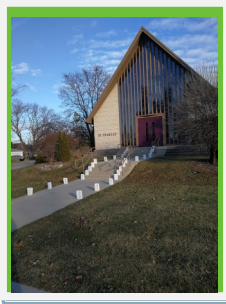

## Menomonee Falls Memorial Tribute

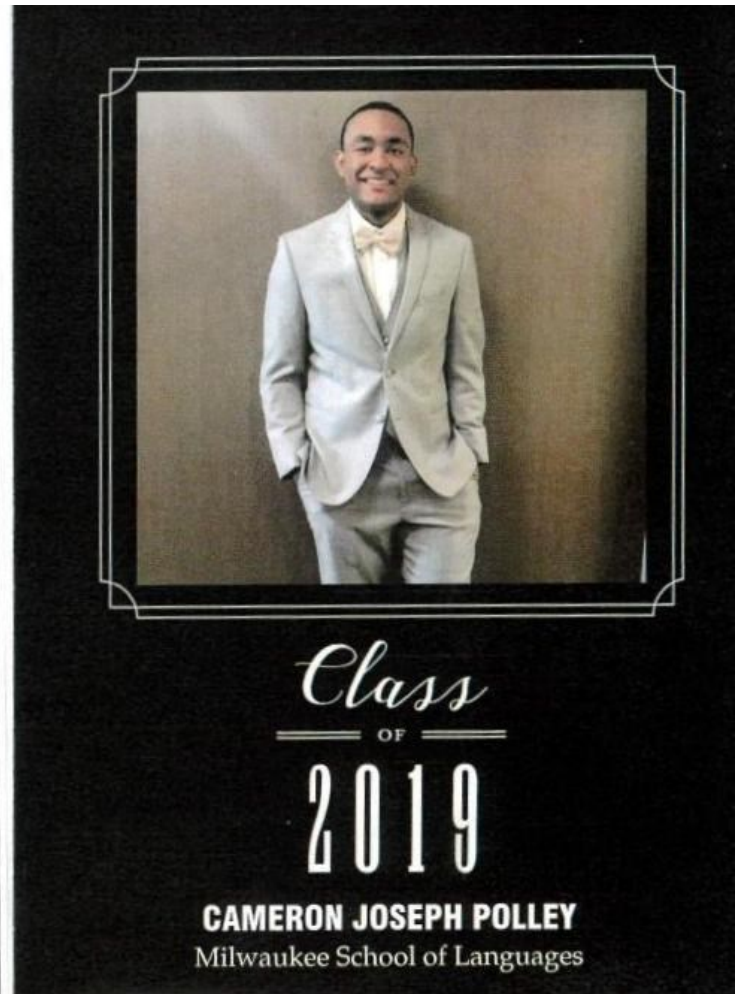

Greetings from your brothers and sisters in Christ at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin.

This year the chancel choir will host a concert and afternoon of prayer and reflection to which we would like to extend a heartfelt invitation to come join us in song! Our concert will feature four major choral works from highly acclaimed composer Dan Forrest. The selections are his "Requiem for the Living." His composition for the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of The Reformation, "A Mighty Fortress is Our God." His Christmas composition "Blessed is the Lord, (Benedictus)" and his commissioned work for the re-dedication of the Duke University Chapel "The Church's One Foundation.'

We are excited to extend this invitation to all people from high school and up who love to sing. The choir will be singing in 8 part, so the part top range is listed here. 1<sup>st</sup> Soprano (high A) 1<sup>st</sup> Alto (high E) 1<sup>st</sup> Tenor (High A) Baritone (high E). This is important to communicate to me so that I can provide the proper rehearsal CD for your part as you learn it over the summer while going about your everyday life.

Rehearsals will begin on Friday, September 20, 27 October 4, 11, 18 (with orchestra) at 7:00 pm. The concert is on Sunday, October 20 at 4:00 pm.

It is essential that I am contacted with your name, address, phone number, email, and voice as soon as possible so that I can prepare your scores. My email is listed as well as church contact information. The following will be provided and required to be returned at the end of the concert: One "Requiem for the Living" score which will also include the three anthems reprinted with permission and bound together by Bechenhorst Press for this concert. One rehearsal CD with your particular vocal part brought to the front of the recording with the other parts and orchestra in the background, and a phonetic pronunciation sheet of the Latin. You are not required to return the information sheet.

I hope you can come and join us! In 2017, we had over 30 guests as we presented the Reformation concert, and it was a wonderful experience. Please invite your friends who love to sing and lift your voices with us as we "make a joyful noise unto the Lord."
